What is a CSA?

Robyn Van En explained it as "food producers + food consumers + annual commitment to one another = CSA and untold possibilities" It is a connection between the farmer and the people who eat the food that the farmer produces. For most people in the United States this connection has been broken. A CSA makes the connection for people so that they can receive fresh organic healthy food from a local source while providing the farmer with a salary that is enough to preserve the family farm for agriculture, wildlife habitat, and open space.
